looking at that photograph to the police officers? 2 A ... "That looks like the guy". 3 And when you say "that looks like the 4 guy", to whom are you referring? 5 The guy that was there that day. 6 Α. Okay. At some point later did you have 7 Q. an opportunity to look a photo lineup? 8 9 A. Yes. Was that at the Walnut Creek Police 10 Q. 11 Department? 12 Α. Yes. And prior to looking at that, to 13 Ο. looking at that photo lineup were you given a photo 14 lineup admonishment where one of the detectives 15 said "it's important for you to -- we are going to 16 have you look at a series of photographs or group 17 of photographs. It is -- don't assume anything by 18 the fact that we are showing you these photographs. 19 20 It is as important to point out the innocent, or free the innocent as it is to point out the 21 22 guilty", something along those lines? 23 Uh-huh. Α. Is that a yes? 24 Q. 25 Α. Yes. Did you understand those instructions? 26 Q. 27 Α. Yes. Now, prior to viewing that photographic 28 Q.

lineup do you remember anybody making any comments 1 to you about who the suspect was from anybody else, 2 that somebody else had identified somebody or 3 anything like that?
