9 A. I only looked at him from the waist up

12 Q. You don't know one way or another  
13 anything about the black bag?

14 A. That's correct.

15 Q. Counsel asked you some questions both  
16 last week and today about what you could see and at  
17 one point last week you said you I couldn't see  
18 very well at that point, referencing the ambulance  
19 ride to the hospital?

20 A. That's correct.

21 Q. ~~Did your vision get worse throughout~~  
22 ~~this several hours that you were in the laundry~~  
23 ~~room?~~

24 A. Yes.

25 Q. Why was that?

26 A. ~~Because the spray started out on my~~  
27 ~~chest, there was a lot of it on my chest.~~ And I  
28 laid on the ~~counter and it got up in my~~ face.

1 Q. Were you hit primarily in the chest  
2 with the pepper spray?

3 A. Yes, and then in the face and eyes.

4 Q. When were you hit in the face and the  
5 eyes?

6 A. Well, after -- after several sprays in  
7 the chest.

8 Q. Were you still able to see when you  
9 were in the laundry room?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. And were you able to see prior to going  
12 into the laundry room?

13 A. Yes.

14 Q. Were you ~~able to see~~ Joshua?

15 A. Absolutely.

16 Q. Were you able to see Joshua when you  
17 started heading towards the laundry after the  
18 defendant grabbed you in the hallway?

19 A. Yes.

20 Q. Were you able to see the defendant in  
21 the doorway of the laundry room?

22 A. Yes, after I was inside and turned  
23 around.

24 Q. Were you able to see Joshua at that  
25 point?

26 A. Yes, I was behind him.

27 Q. Were you able to see the door of the  
28 laundry room?

- 1 A. Yes.
- 2 Q. Could you see the clothing?
- 3 A. Yes.
- 4 Q. That was hanging between the counter  
5 and the door?
- 6 A. Yes, I was to the left of that  
7 clothing.
- 8 Q. And could you ~~see the phone~~?
- 9 A. Yeah, well it was behind the clothing,  
10 I could reach it.
- 11 Q. When you grabbed it, did you, did you  
12 dial 911?
- 13 A. Yes, that was after the door was  
14 closed.
- 15 Q. Okay. And did you have to dial several  
16 times?
- 17 A. No, once.
- 18 Q. Could you see the ~~button~~ on the phone?
- 19 A. Yes.
- 20 Q. Did you have any ~~trouble~~?
- 21 A. ~~No.~~
- 22 Q. What did the -- whatever this person,  
23 the defendant, sprayed in your face or on your  
24 chest initially what did that smell like?
- 25 A. I don't remember it just started  
26 burning you know, my skin and --
