hear people walking around in your house? 1 Yes, I have carpet on the floor, too, 2 Α. 3 so --When you heard the door open and close 4 Q. 5 when you were in the laundry then you went to go see what was going on? 6 7 Α. Yes. 8 Did you hear any footsteps or anything 9 after you heard the door open and close? Α. 10 No. 11 Q. And you had to walk a little ways 12 before you got around the corner of that hallway to 13 be able to see the person; is that right? That's correct. 14 Α. 15 And when you got there and got around 16 the corner what was the person doing at that time 17 when you first saw him? 18 Standing there with a spray bottle. 19 Q. Now, you are holding your left hand up 20 kind of near your cheek with your index finger? 21 Α. Uh-huh. 22 Q. Pushing down? 23 Α. Like this (indicating). 24 Is that what they were doing when you Q. 25 first saw them? 26 A. Well, they weren't spraying yet. 27 were holding it and then after I got there they 28 started spraying.

Okay. So by the time you got around 1 Q. the corner the person's arm was up, though, in the 2 manner you showed? 3 That's correct. 4 5 And it was your testimony that 6 immediately upon coming around that corner you 7 recognized the person? That's correct. 8 Α. 9 Do -- we talked the other day about Mr. Mendell's vehicle was vandalized also prior to 10 11 this incident? 12 Α. That's correct. 13 And do you recall an incident where one of the Latteri work trucks was also vandalized 1.4 during the construction? 15 16 Α. No. 17 Now, you testified earlier that you 18 were absolutely sure the person was not wearing 19 gloves, that's correct? 20 Only in the laundry-room they were not 21 wearing gloves. I did not testify about the other, 22 I wasn't sure, and I told the officer that at the time. 23 24 Certainly during the very brief 25 interaction you had with this person before you got 26 into the laundry room you didn't see them either 27 putting on or taking off gloves; is that correct?
